

Tour the Lockheed Martin Space Systems facility (now known as United Launch Alliance)

Tour the Lockheed Martin Space Systems Tank Assembly facility where the Atlas booster and Centaur propellant tanks are manufactured. The tanks use an innovative steel balloon architecture initially developed for America's first operational ICBM.

The tour is scheduled for Wednesday, March 18th, at 2 PM and will last 2-3 hours. **YOU MUST BE A US CITIZEN TO ATTEND THIS TOUR.** A government issued ID with picture (e.g. driver's license, passport, military ID) is required to tour the facility. The tour will be limited to 20 people on a first-come first-serve basis.

DIRECTIONS:

From I-5 Southbound, after I-8 take the Old Town Ave exit, go straight onto Hancock St, turn right onto Witherby St, veer to right onto Pacific Highway, move to left to exit onto Barnett Ave, turn right onto Midway Drive, turn right onto Enterprise St. Park close to the pedestrian overpass.

From I-5 Northbound, take the Pacific Highway exit, go about 1.5 miles, move to left to exit onto Barnett Ave, turn right onto Midway Drive, turn right onto Enterprise St. Park close to the pedestrian overpass.
